

ARTS ALIVE! 2016 PARTICIPATION APPLICATION

Between now and February 26, 2016, the Prince William County Arts Council will accept Participation Proposal Forms for the three "Arts Alive!" street festivals planned for fiscal year 2016:

- Saturday, April 30th, 12:00 5:00 PM: The PWC Arts Council will join forces with the Woodbridge Campus of Northern Virginia Community College to present "Woodbridge Alive", an afternoon of arts, food, and wellness information. The event will include an "Artists Corral" a special area for you, the artists, to interact directly with the community with a focus on advice from you on how to parlay art into a career or serious avocation. Vendor spots will be available to Arts Council members wishing to sell tickets or works for the discounted rate of \$75 (the non-Arts Council rate is \$150).
- Friday, May 6th, 6:00 9:00 PM: We will cram as much art as possible into every nook and cranny of Old Town Manassas at the "Spring Gallery Walk Sponsored by Historic Manassas, Inc. and the Prince William County Arts Council". In addition to utilizing spaces such as Harris Pavilion and the grounds of the Manassas Museum, we will close the area to vehicle traffic as the various merchants of Historic Manassas host visual and performing artists in their stores and on the streets.
- Saturday, June 18th, 4:00 8:00 PM: Poetry, music, visual art, food, and more will be featured at the "Arts Council Summerfest at Tacketts Mill". Among other artsy offerings, we will crown the new Prince William County Poet Laureate.

Admission to all of the Arts Alive! Street Festivals will be free, open to the public, and held rain or shine. Arts Council members are encouraged to submit proposals for as many of the Festivals as they like; the organizers will do their best to accommodate everyone. Proposals may include performances, displays, readings, book signings, classes, workshops, and/or demonstrations. Each Festival will include an Arts Council Pop-up Bookstore featuring AC swag and Arts Council member promotional materials.
