Submit your applications with the students' works, ages, composer name, time of piece, etc ... will be in the same format as in the previous recitals. Students should be prepared to play on any one of the three programs. Hence, performers from the same studio may be on different recitals during the afternoon, contributing to the diversity in the programming. Teachers should be prepared for this possibility. However, we will do our best to keep siblings on the same program. Please mark on the application which students have siblings to assist in this process of putting those siblings on the same recital. We do make mistakes, please let us know if we have forgotten to put siblings together or have inadvertently missed your application. Gold Cup student recipients are free/NO COST.
